Concentrated portfolio of 20 stocks with high earnings growth. Each of the portfolio companies are market leaders in their respective segments.

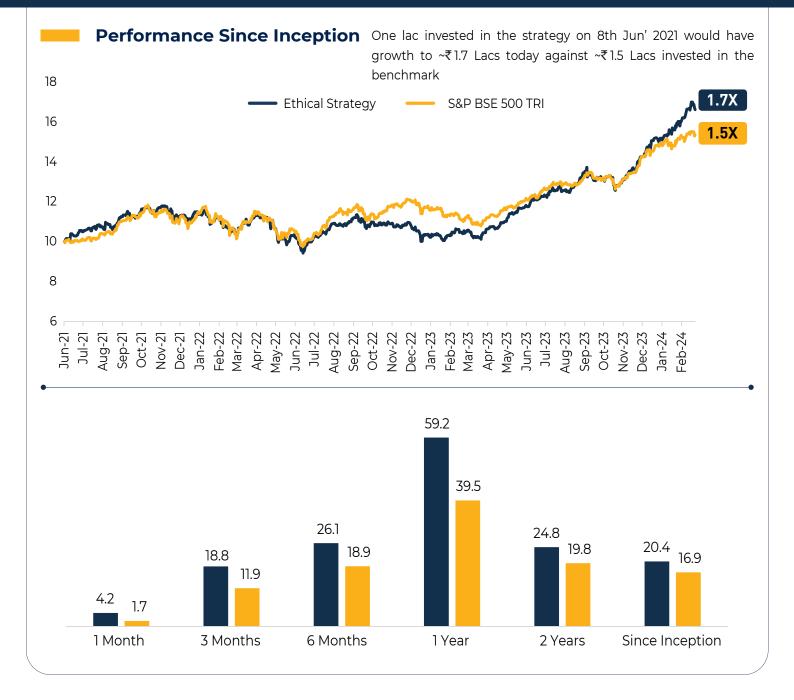
